Code of Conduct

- Members are to participate in a polite, honest and respectful manner in dealings with fellow members, officials and others associated with BRC. Inappropriate behaviour and / or abusive language will not be tolerated.

- Members should encourage and support new and/or less skilled members during BRC events.
- Members must accept responsibility for their actions, both mounted and unmounted.
- Members are not to engage in riding which will endanger themselves or others during BRC events.
- Members should make a commitment to the club by providing assistance and support for BRC events, even when not riding.
- Members should not be under the influence of alcohol or performance inhibiting drugs during BRC events.
- Members should ensure they understand the rules and policies of BRC and follow them.
- Members should not use their involvement with BRC to promote their own beliefs, behaviours or practices where these are inconsistent with those of the BRC.
- Members will refrain from any form of harassment of others.
- Members will refrain from any behaviour that may bring the BRC into disrepute.
- Members will show consideration and support towards others who may be sick or injured during a BRC event.
